Enhancements to PUB Drainage Interpretation Requisitions (DIP)

We are grateful for your support for InteReq for the last 20 years.

Please take note that the Public Utilities Board (PUB) Catchment and Waterway Department (CWD) has made revisions to the Drainage Interpretation Plan (DIP) requisition in these areas. The changes will come into effect from 1 August 2019.

Online Form

1. Solicitor in-charge will be a mandatory field for DIP requisitions when you complete the legal requisition form in InteReq. The DIP will be addressed specifically to the solicitor-in-charge.

Fees and Charges

1. DIP requisitions will be by lot number. A fee will be levied on per lot number basis.
2. It will be \$14 per lot number for a return report [No change in fee]. There will not be any charge for invalid lot number submitted to PUB-CWD

Replies

1. Get your DIP replies within the same day
2. The DIP reply {PDF report sent to law firms currently} will not include the response. Instead the reply will direct you to a DIP attachment which you can download to see the detailed results. Please [click here](#) to view the sample DIP Reply.
